## STATEMENT OF CHANGES IN IMMIGRATION RULES

The Home Secretary has, with effect from 1 April 1994, made the changes hereinafter stated in the Rules laid down by him as to the practice to be followed in the administration of the Immigration Act 1971 for regulating entry into and the stay of persons in the United Kingdom and contained in the statement laid before Parliament on 23 March 1990 (HC 251) as amended.\*

In paragraph 1 of the said statement the second sentence which begins "For the purposes of these rules" shall be deleted and at the end there shall be added the following:

"For the purposes of these Rules the term "public funds" means:

- (i) housing under Part III of the Housing Act 1985, Part II of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1987 or Part II of the Housing (Northern Ireland) Order 1988.
- (ii) income support, family credit, council tax benefit and housing benefit under Part VII of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992; and
- (iii) income support, family credit and housing benefit under Part VII of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits (Northern Ireland) Act 1992."
