

List of suitable candidate indicators for further development.

Indicators from phase 1 that warrant further investigation:

1. Accommodation status - completeness
2. Accommodation - in settled accommodation
3. Serious untoward incidents
4. Admission rates
5. Section usage
6. Readmission rates
7. Percentage of discharges followed up within 7 days of people on CPA
8. Percentage of service users on CPA reviewed annually
9. Crisis resolution Home Treatment episode rates
10. Waiting times
11. MHCT – HONOS
12. Physical health- smoking cessation
13. Physical health – BMI / Waist
14. Physical health Check
15. Average length of stay
16. Duration of untreated psychosis
17. London physical health CQINN measures: (It was decided to look at these along -side the existing physical health measures during the analytical phase and to include in phase 3).
18. Service user experience.
19. Waiting times for access to services – This has been put forward by a number of stakeholders including commissioners. This was assessed against the selection criteria and scored a total of 12, therefore assessed as a good measure but may require further work in terms of collection and could be included in phase 3.
20. Use of anti-psychotic drugs – work is on-going but not sufficiently robust to include, however could be included in phase 3.
21. The 'percentage of service users stepping up and down' clusters
22. percentage exceeding expected cluster duration'
23. Crisis Resolution and Home Treatment
24. Safe and high quality care
25. Information for people in receipt of care and treatment
26. Increased choice of care and treatment.
27. The following indicators link with QIPP:
 - 'Average number of bed days per annum, average length of stay (in-patients) admission rates & Readmission rates' are service measures. It is unclear what quality indication this would provide, though there is value in considering if this can be included in any way.
 - Although these may be used as a QIPP measure we may want to use the CRHT measure as a quality measure to off set the inpatient data as a proxy quality measure.
