The Government will examine and evaluate all of the evidence and support received during the consultation before making any decisions on how to progress. Australia has already moved to introduce plain packaging and it is due to come in to law in December this year. Keep up to date with all developments here or @plainpacks.

#### From Fiona Andrews Director of Smokefree South West



It is a real credit to everyone, and especially those here in the South West, that we have seen such support for a measure that could help move cigarettes out of glamorous, glitzy and expensively designed boxes, protecting future generations from the dangers of smoking.

So many people have played a key role in spreading the message. Examples come to mind such as volunteers in Devon standing for two days at the County Show (in summer rain!) and Torbay's fantastic plain packs shop window, Wiltshire out and about encouraging large scale public support and North Somerset engaging school councils.

All of this has been enhanced behind the scenes. Alliance leads have

done a brilliant job in supporting detailed responses to the consultation from local authorities, clinical commissioning groups and other bodies.

Smokers and non-smokers, young and old, uncles and aunties, parents and grandparents have shown support for plain, standardised packaging looking to protect future generations from a lifetime of addiction and possible premature death.
