FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000

I refer to your e-mail of 16th March 2011 in which you asked whether there were any concessions in the MOT process for members of the Plymouth Brethren. We have dealt with this under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Any vehicle which requires an MOT test (ie has reached 3 years old) requires an MOT test. The Vehicle and Operator Services Agency (VOSA) does not hold details of the keeper or presenter of vehicles for MOT tests. All vehicles/tests are recorded on the MOT computer database. There are no concessions to this.
