Thank you for your e-mail of 22nd December 2013 requesting details on the Department of Energy and Climate Change (DECC) expenditure on Christmas Parties.

Specifically you asked -

- how much the Office spent on this year's Christmas Party
- where it was held
- when it was held
- · the cost of hiring the venue
- · the cost of the food and drink and
- whether any entertainment was provided.

Additionally you asked how much the Office spent on Christmas decorations for their Office this year and how much was spent on buying and sending Christmas cards.

I can confirm that the Department of Energy and Climate Change did not host any Christmas or New Year parties paid from public funds last year nor were any official Christmas cards sent out from this Department.
