

## ESF Programme Summary – Workplace Learning

### Overview

The purpose of this provision is to promote the in-work progression of employed individuals with low skills levels through the delivery of work related skills training, raising their level of attainment, enabling individuals to improve their employment status and to move on to undertake higher levels of training. This is particularly aimed at those people more vulnerable to future unemployment, with barriers to achieving sustainable employment. For example, this would include people who are now in employment, but who were recently unemployed (aged between 19 and 24, and not in education, employment or training (NEET)).

Individuals must be aged 19 or over, be eligible for Agency and ESF funding under the normal rules as defined in our Funding Rules. Qualifications include Level 2 (Level 3 provision is only available aged between 19 and 24 within SMEs, whose highest previous qualification is below Level 3).

The principal outcome of the activity will be in-work progression **measured by one or more** of the following, leading to a single progression payment per individual supported.

**Starting an Apprenticeship/Higher Apprenticeship** and sustaining retention on the Apprenticeship for a minimum continuous 6-week period in order to formally register an Apprenticeship start; or

**Starting on QCF-regulated skills training at a higher level** (including Higher Education), or other training not funded in this specification, and sustaining retention on the training for a continuous 6-week period; or

**Moving into secure employment** (with the same or a different employer), meaning:- *From temporary to permanent work* within 26 weeks of being supported by the programme; or - *A sustained increase in working hours* such as the shift from working part time (below 30 hours a week) at the start of engagement to full-time (at least 35 hours a week) work measured over a continuous 26-week period.

**Promotion or increased responsibility:** as evidenced by a statement from the employer and an increase in wages.

All of these contracts will end by 31 July 2015.
