

FIRE SAFETY MODULE 3**General Information**

The Fire Safety Module 3 Course is designed to provide students with the functional requirements to carry out fire safety tasks (under the supervision of the Group Fire Safety Advisor) when dealing with Core Works and / or Major Projects

Formal Training

The course consists of 5 days training (spread over 1 week) which currently covers:

- Crown Fire Standards
- Approved Document 'B'
- BS 5839 Pt 1
- Role of the Project Fire Officer
- DSEAR
- RRO & DFRMO as the Enforcing Authority
- BS 5588 series
- Alternative Approaches to Compliance

The Fire Safety Module 3 is a demanding course where students are required to retain both the knowledge imparted to them and self study the précis supplied. During the course the students will have to demonstrate to the instructors that they understand the principles of Core Works and Major Projects

Assessment Strategy

The students will have to complete a consolidation exercise which comprises of a change of use of an existing building using plans and various reference guides.

Eligibility

Personnel to be trained Must:

- a. Be a minimum of DFRMO Fire Station Manager, or
- b. DFRMO Sub Officer/SNCO where it can be justified that there is a need for this training, and receives the approval of the BTM, or

- c. Non MOD Fire & Rescue Service personnel (subject to spare capacity, payment and prior approval of BTM).

Fire Station Managers are responsible for confirming that students nominated for the Fire Safety Module 3 course meet the above criteria.
