Background

Social Fund Community Care Grants are available to vulnerable people claiming income-related benefits in the following situations.

- To help people moving out of institutional or residential care to establish themselves in the community.
- To help people stay in the community.
- To ease exceptional pressure on families.
- To help people setting up home as part of a planned programme of resettlement.
- To help with the care of a prisoner or young offender on release on temporary licence.
- To assist with certain travelling expenses.

There is a cash-limited budget for Great Britain which is allocated to 23 Jobcentre Plus Social Fund budget areas.

Methodology

The results given below are Management Information. DWP's preference is to provide Official/National Statistics, but in this case only Management Information is available. It is not quality assured to the same extent as Official/National Statistics. The Great Britain figure is from the Social Fund White Paper Account for 2009-10, but this Account does not include a regional breakdown. A regional breakdown is available only from the DWP Social Fund Policy, Budget and Management Information System, but this does not include awards processed clerically which had not yet been entered on to the Social Fund Computer System (which represent about 1.4% of the Great Britain expenditure in the Account). That regional breakdown has been scaled to give the Great Britain total in the Account.
