The Primary Medical Services (Electronic Prescription Service Authorisation) (Amendment) Directions 2012

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 8(1), 272(7) and 273(1) of the National Health Service Act 2006(a), gives the following Directions.

Citation, commencement and application
