Thank you for your email of 09 September 2013 where you requested the following information:

How much money have you spent on Twitter training since May 2010?

- Who received this training?
- What kind of training did they receive?
- Who conducted the training?

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'), you have the right to:

- know whether we hold the information you require
- be provided with that information (subject to any exemptions under the Act which may apply).

I can confirm that the Department holds the information you have requested and that no money has been spent on Twitter training since May 2010. To date Twitter training has been conducted in house by the DECC Digital Team.

Appeals Procedure

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be sent to the Information Rights Unit at:
