SCHEDULE FOR THE PUBLICATION OF OFFICIAL STATISTICS OCTOBER 2011 TO MARCH 2013

INTRODUCTION

This Statistical First Release (SFR) announces the planned schedule for the publication of statistics by the Department for Education (DfE) for the period October 2011 to March 2013. The schedule covers the National Statistics and Official Statistics that DfE expects to publish throughout the next 18 months. National Statistics are the subset of Official Statistics that have been assessed or deemed to be compliant with the Code of Practice for Official Statistics.

The schedule lists the National Statistics publications (SFRs, Bulletins and Volumes) and official statistics publications due to be released in each of the next six months, and provides a provisional list for the following twelve months. Specific release dates will be announced at least 4 weeks in advance of release on DfE's Research and Statistics Gateway, at:

For statistical releases with fixed release dates, specific release dates are given here in this schedule.

Statistical Releases are normally released at 09:30 and are made available to all users at that time.

REVISIONS TO THE SCHEDULE

If the Department publishes or plans to publish any statistics not listed in the schedule then these statistics will be announced on the Research and Statistics Gateway and UK Statistics Authority Publication Hub mentioned above. If it proves necessary to change any pre-announced release date, an explanation will be provided as far in advance as possible of the planned release date. The next schedule is due to be announced in March 2012.

This schedule covers the period from October 2011 to March 2013 and reflects the position as at the point of publication. Additional ongoing work to reduce data burdens or rationalise outputs may impact on the publication programme. Announcements will be made on our Research and Statistics Gateway when definitive information is available. Known changes in scope or discontinuations are listed below.

CHANGES IN SCOPE OF PUBLICATION

Official Statistics: Diploma Learning, England, 2010/11

This Official Statistics Release was last published in November 2010 and contained figures showing participation in and achievement of 14-19 Diplomas during 2009/10. This year, only achievement figures will be published, as the data are not maintained locally with sufficient accuracy to enable identification of those participating in the latest year. As the Diploma is now an established qualification it is the intention that, after this year, its reporting will be brought into line with other qualifications available to 14-19 year olds. Consultation will be undertaken shortly on whether, as a result, this publication should be discontinued.

Interim Results for Key Stage 2 & 3 National Curriculum Assessments in England, 2010/11

Interim Percentage of Pupils Making Expected Progress in English and in Mathematics between Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 in England, 2010/11

We intend to consult with our users on changes to the timing and scope of these publications to ensure that they continue to reflect user needs and take into account changes to Key Stage 2 assessment arrangements. We expect headline statistics and progression measures to be published in August or September 2012. Following our discussions with users we will communicate any changes to the scope of these publications or their release dates via the Department's Research and Statistics Gateway and future publication schedules.

2012 Year 1 Phonics Screening Check

The Department for Education has announced plans to introduce a new assessment of pupil's phonic decoding ability from June 2012. It is expected that this information will be collected from schools by local authorities and other accredited agencies and submitted to the Department by the end of July 2012. It is intended that national, regional and local authority statistics on the Year 1 Phonics Screening Check will be combined with the publication of National Curriculum Assessments at Key Stage 1 in England, 2011/12 and published in September 2012.

Behaviour in schools in England at December 2011

The official statistics on Behaviour in Schools in England at December 2011 are scheduled for publication in April 2012. Ofsted are considering making more data available in the future including the figures provided in this publication, which may negate the need for DfE to publish this data.

School Destinations of Secondary School Pupils Resident in London Boroughs, 2011

The Statistical Bulletin on School Destinations of Secondary School Pupils Resident in London Boroughs, 2011 was scheduled for publication in September 2011. This has been delayed pending consultation with users on the requirements for publication including the possible discontinuation of this publication. The consultation is taking place during September 2011. If the Department decides to continue to publish the Bulletin then it will be published in either January or February 2012, with the updated 'School Destinations of Secondary School Pupils Resident in London Boroughs, 2012' to be published in September 2012.

DELAYED PUBLICATIONS

Childcare and Early Years Survey of Parents 2010

The results of this survey were scheduled to be published in October 2011. Owing to necessary data verification work, the results of this survey will be published in April - May 2012. As a result, the planned September 2012 publication 'Children and Early Years Survey of Parents 2011' has also been delayed and will be published in November-December 2012.

Additional tables

In addition to the main releases listed, further information is often released in the form of additional tables. Typically, these may be Local Authority level tables relating to the national tables in the main release, or updated tables using revised or final data. These additional tables will be either identified within the releases themselves or separately announced on our website. They are not listed separately in this schedule.

Underlying data

As part of a Government drive for improved data transparency, we will simultaneously release the underlying data alongside the main publication, or make it available as soon as possible after the release of the main publication. Where data protection and resources permit, this supporting data will include a combination of files in an open standardised format and data at finer levels of detail. In some instances underlying data will not be released at the same time as the main publication. Publications where this is the case include:

Volume: Education and Training Statistics for the United Kingdom: 2011

This release will be published in December 2011. No underlying data will be published.

Children Looked After by Local Authorities in England – Year Ending 31 March 2012

This release will be published in September 2012, with the underlying data published in November 2012.
