Thank you for the revised minutes from JTI's meeting with the DH on 5th February. Please see attached for a draft which accepts all of the changes made by the DH and shows two further changes proposed by JTI – in track changes. For ease of reference, I also list below the proposed changes with our reasons for their inclusion:

Inclusion of the phrase "who provided their independent opinions" in reference to Professor Zimmerman and Chaudhry's report: Professors Zimmerman and Chaudhry's analysis represents their independent opinions (as they themselves state in the report: "We

have been requested to prepare this report for Japan Tobacco International (JTI). However, the views expressed are our own and build on our expertise in the area of illicit trade."). This is a point on which the experts feel particularly strongly and something we stressed during the meeting hence the statement reflects the discussion and should be included the minutes.

Reference to the Cogent research being commissioned by the TMA: the Cogent research was commissioned by the TMA, and not JTI.

I would be most grateful if you could confirm whether the DH are able to accept these amendments in the final meeting minutes.

The second type is 'qualified' exemption, whereby information can only be withheld if the balance of the public interest, in all the circumstances of the case, favours maintaining the exemption of the information. 





Thank you for meeting with and me on 5th February to discuss aspects of JTI's response to the Consultation on the Standardised Packaging of Tobacco Products and accompanying draft Impact Assessment.

Please find attached a PDF of the slides presented during our meeting. As agreed, we have redacted commercially sensitive and confidential parts of the slides (slides 6, 7 and 9). We have done our utmost to leave the slides intact as much as possible and, therefore, have only redacted information which relates to pack images and pricing information that are highly confidential and commercially sensitive.

In addition, at our meeting we provided for you copies of our price list which identified recommended retail prices applicable from March to September 2012. We did so noting that price list information is treated by JTI as being confidential and commercially sensitive and recognising the fact that, as the Department of Health (DH) will be aware, competition law concerns can arise from disclosure of sensitive commercial information. In providing you with such information, we wish to be very clear that we expect you to resist vigorously any Freedom of Information request that you may receive where our commercially sensitive information may be in scope. We would expect you to adopt the same approach as the competition authorities to protect commercially sensitive information - which is to resist disclosure forcefully.

We provided you with an additional copy of JTI's Response to the DH's Consultation on the Standardised Packaging of Tobacco Products including the expert reports annexed to it. As we explained at the meeting, the attached presentation should not be regarded as encapsulating all of JTI's views. Our full consultation response explains in more detail why JTI is categorically opposed to the plain packaging of tobacco products. It also provides our views on Better Regulation and the flawed and incomplete evidence base that underpinned the consultation.

We also confirmed that Dr Andrew Lilico might be able to provide further detail or clarification on his report (*Economic Analysis of a Plain Packs Requirement in the UK, A Report from Europe Economics*) if it would be helpful to the DH. Furthermore, we suggested that the DH ought to discuss with retail representative bodies the role of the cash flow and footfall generated by the tobacco category in sustaining the financial position of community retailers.


Lastly, we would be grateful if you could confirm when we can expect the draft meeting minutes for our review.

On a separate note, we also relayed our concern regarding the closure of Arista UK's laboratory at our meeting. The Tobacco Manufacturers' Association (TMA) informed us of your email to them dated 13 February – thank you for letting us know that you are looking into the matter. We are conscious the 9 March deadline for the delivery of samples pursuant to the DH's guidance to date, is fast approaching. Therefore, we would be grateful for your guidance on the delivery arrangement for the samples as soon as possible. In the event that we do not receive further guidance by 28 February, please note that we will carry out the testing of the samples in our EU-approved laboratory in Trier, Germany, in order to fulfil our sampling & TNCO verification requirement in the UK.

Please let us know if we can be of further assistance.

European Commission's proposal to revise the Tobacco Products Directive 2001/37/EC

Further to my email below and our meeting on 5 February during which we discussed the European Commission's proposal to revise the Tobacco Products Directive, adopted on 19 December 2012 (the Proposal) and your invitation to correspond at any time, I wanted to clarify ourposition. On 20 December 2012, Ireland's Department of Health launched a public consultation on the Proposal, which closed on 16 January. JTI submitted its response to this consultation (a copy of which is attached) setting out our early views on the Proposal from an Irish market perspective.

JTI supports the primary aims of the Proposal, namely that minors should not smoke and should not be able to obtain tobacco products. Indeed, JTI does not object to all of the elements of the Proposal and positively welcomes certain aspects. For example, the introduction of a standardised and harmonised ingredients reporting process as based on EMTOC (Electronic Model Tobacco Control) and the 2007 EU Practical Guide would be a helpful development (if the ingredients regime is not expanded in such a way as to become unworkable). However, the key measures included in the Proposal suffer from very significant procedural, evidential, legal and constitutional flaws.

The measures set out in the Proposal lack credible evidence that they will prove effective, achieving neither Internal Market (the 27 Member States will be able to impose different regulations) nor public health objectives. JTI agrees with appropriate and proportionate regulation of tobacco products, but the Proposal is neither, in its construction or content. Without credible evidence, the measures are profoundly disproportionate and bring into question the competence of the EU to legislate.

The Proposal would have widespread negative effects, not least an increase in the availability of smuggled and counterfeit tobacco products. Insofar as the substance of the Proposal is concerned, the measures proposed will inhibit innovation in the industry, despite EU and UK policy explicitly promoting innovation and when it is apparent that innovative designs deter counterfeiters. The unsubstantiated, disproportionate measures in the Proposal include:

- · imposing **outsized pictorial health warnings** covering 75% of the front and back pack surfaces, positioned at the top edge and leaving inadequate space for branding;
- banning entire categories of products menthol and small diameter cigarettes that are manufactured and sold legally to millions of adult customers throughout the EU and which represent some 9% of UK cigarette sales;
- prescribing minimum pack sizes the Proposal would ban all rolling tobacco packs below 40g (78.6% of all rolling tobacco sold in the UK is in 12.5g or 25g pack sizes) and all cigarette packs with less than 20 cigarettes (25.8% of all cigarettes sold in the UK are in sub-20s format, with 10s packs predominant). Together, these make up some 41% of the UK tobacco market; this despite the fact that in 2008 following a public consultation the UK Government decided not to increase minimum pack sizes:

- prescribing extensive details of **pack design**, including shape, size, materials, opening mechanisms, and further prescribing descriptors, so as to significantly homogenise the market, damage brands and prevent innovation;
- banning various ingredients, without any scientific basis, and requiring the Member States to set up disparate and costly ingredient-by-ingredient analysis regimes, with no apparent purpose; and
 - expanding the ingredients regimeto make it unworkable.

The Proposal also seeks to transfer powers from the Member States, the Council and European Parliament to the Commission, across 16 areas, allowing the Commission to make dramatic changes to the regulation of tobacco products without appropriate legislative scrutiny. In particular, the Proposal transfers indefinite, ill-defined and almost unfettered "delegated" and "implementing" powers to the Commission, thereby enabling the Commission to adopt yet further public health motivated regulation without the proper oversight of Member States, the Council and the European Parliament.

The extent of these powers reflects the Proposal's disregard for the principle of subsidiarity, as enshrined in Article 5 of the Treaty on European Union, as it seeks to regulate public health in circumstances where harmonisation in this area is expressly excluded (by virtue of Article 168(5) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union). The Proposal effectively transfers public health policy regarding tobacco products (and indeed non-tobacco products) to the EU.

Indeed, the European Scrutiny Committee of the House of Commons has already conducted a preliminary assessment of the Proposal noting that the timetable is "ambitious" and has requested further information from the Government on whether the legal base is "appropriate" or gives rise to concerns about subsidiarity. It is also worth noting that both the Italian Senate and the Czech Republic Committee for the European Union have both already given negative opinions in relation to the Proposal and subsidiarity.

In addition, JTI has concerns regarding the interaction between the Proposal and the UK Consultation on Standardised Packaging of Tobacco Products and the Department of Health's

(DH) on-going work in that area. As raised with you at our meeting on 5 February, JTI remains unclear as to the DH's position on its current work on plain packaging in the light of the Proposal, and also the DH's views on the EU's impact assessment accompanying the Proposal. We would encourage the DH to consider undertaking a public consultation similar to that undertaken by Ireland, in order to canvass views on the Proposal from a UK perspective and inform the DH's position on these issues.

JTI is committed to playing an important role in the development of an appropriate and proportionate regulatory regime for tobacco products. In light of the concerns we have highlighted above (and expanded on more fully in the enclosed response) we would welcome the opportunity to discuss these issues with you further.
