## Quarterly Manning Report :

### TSP10 – 1 October 2011

This statistical release presents figures on the National and International locations of all UK Regular Armed Forces Personnel and MOD civilian personnel. It sources military data from the Ministry of Defence Joint Personnel Administration System (JPA) and civilian data from the Human Resource and Management System (HRMS). Due to ongoing validation of data from JPA, UK Regular Forces location data are currently provisional and subject to review.

The tables present information on the stationed location of all UK Regular service and civilian personnel by UK Unitary Authority and Local Authority Area, as well as all international global locations. Data is presented for each Service by Officer / Rank breakdown and non industrial / industrial breakdowns for civilian personnel (including Trading Funds and Locally Engaged Civilians).

### Key Points and Trends

- At 1 October 2011, 87% of UK Regular Armed Forces and 82% of MOD civilian personnel were stationed in the UK.
- The strength of UK Regular Forces stationed in the UK fell by 3,590 (2.0%) between 1 October 2010 and 1 October 2011 from 163,660 to 160,070. Over the same period, the number of UK civilian personnel decreased from 69,160 to 63,680. The large decrease in civilian personnel includes the departure of 1,960 personnel (headcount) in the Meteorological Office, for whom responsibility has transferred from the Ministry of Defence to the Department for Business, Innovation and Skills (BIS) and 660 locally engaged civilians.
- The strength of UK Regular Forces stationed overseas decreased from 24,610 to 23,570 (4.2%) between 1 October 2010 and 1 October 2011. Over the same period, the number of MOD civilian personnel based overseas decreased from 12,170 to 11,420.
- The number of UK Regular Armed Forces personnel stationed in Germany continued to decrease from 18,540 to 17,820 (3.9%) between 1 October 2010 and 1 October 2011 in line with the announcement made during the Strategic Defence & Security Review (SDSR). Despite this decrease, Germany still has the second largest population of MOD personnel after the UK.

## **Announcement of change to DASA TSP10 Statistical Publication**

Defence Analytical Services and Advice (DASA) has expanded the presentation of location statistics currently published in its Quarterly Publication TSP10 to include both Military and Civilian statistics. This is a continuation of DASA's improvements of its statistical publications, following the creation of the military Monthly Manning Report (MMR) and Quarterly Manning Report (QMR) in 2009.

As of January 2012 TSP10 will cease publication in its current format and be renamed to: **Quarterly Location Statistics – UK Regular Armed Forces and Civilian Personnel.**

### **Key developments include:**

1. inclusion of both UK Regular Armed Forces and Civilian Personnel Statistics;
2. a summary of key points and trends; and
3. more detail on the sources of data and their strengths and weaknesses.

No information will be lost to users. All the tables currently produced will be available to internal and external users, and longer term may be available through DASA's Build Your Own Table (BYOT) tool available via DASA's website [www.dasa.mod.uk](http://www.dasa.mod.uk).

## **Definitions and Notes to tables**

### **UK Regular Forces**

Figures are for UK Regular Forces (including both Trained and Untrained personnel), and therefore exclude Gurkhas, Full Time Reserve Service personnel and mobilised reservists.

Naval Service personnel on sea service are included against the local authority containing the home port of their ship.

Royal Air Force Other Ranks serving in the South Atlantic are shown against the location containing their home base.

Due to ongoing validation of data from the Joint Personnel Administration System all statistics for all three services are provisional and subject to review.

### **MOD Civilian Personnel**

Civilian figures are reported as Full Time Equivalent (FTE). FTE is a measure of the size of the workforce that takes account of the fact that some people work part-time. Part-time staff are counted according to the number of hours they work per week as a proportion of normal hours for their grade and location.

Section -1 civilian personnel total includes Royal Fleet Auxiliary (RFA). RFA civilian personnel cannot be identified by location as the data are not held centrally.

### **Data Sources:**

UK Regular Forces data are sourced from the Joint Personnel Administration (JPA) system. Location data are based on the stationed location of the individual as recorded in the 'Assignment Location' field of the JPA system. The figures are based on Service personnel's stationed location and not their location of residence - where personnel work isn't necessarily where they live. Personnel deployed on operations to an area away from their stationed location are shown against their most recent stationed location.

MOD civilian data are compiled from several sources:

- 1) **Core MOD Personnel** - Data for core MOD personnel are taken from the personnel system - Human Resources Management System (HRMS). DASA use budgetary UINs and attribute people

according to the budgetary area that pays them, using the Standing Data System hierarchy from Financial Management Information Systems.

**2) Trading Funds** - Trading Funds were introduced by the Government under the Trading Funds Act 1973 as a 'means of financing trading operations of a government department which, hitherto, have been carried out on Vote'. They are self-accounting units that have greater freedom, than other government departments, in managing their own financial and management activities. They are also free to negotiate their own terms and conditions with their staff and for this reason their grading structures do not always match that of the rest of the Ministry. Until October 2011, the MOD had four Trading Funds that provide DASA with monthly extracts from their own personnel systems. As 1 October 2011, The Meteorological Office transferred responsibility to the Department for Business, Innovation and Skills, and the Ministry of Defence no longer receive their personnel information.

**3) Locally engaged civilians (LEC)** - LEC employees are recruited overseas exclusively for employment in support of the UK Armed Forces deployed in a particular overseas theatre and on terms and conditions of service applicable only to that overseas theatre or Administration. This includes the dependents of UK military personnel or UK-based civilian staff employed in overseas theatre (who are sometimes separately identified as UK Dependents). LECs are not civil servants. LEC data are provided by Top Level Budgetary areas quarterly to DASA requirements.

**4) The Royal Fleet Auxiliary (RFA)** - RFA data are taken from the MOD civilian pay system.

#### **Data Issues – Strengths/Weaknesses (Data Quality):**

1. All tables presented in this publication meet the high standards of quality and integrity demanded by the Code of Practice for Official Statistics.
2. Due to ongoing validation of data from the JPA System, all Services' strength statistics from 1 May 2009 are provisional and subject to review.

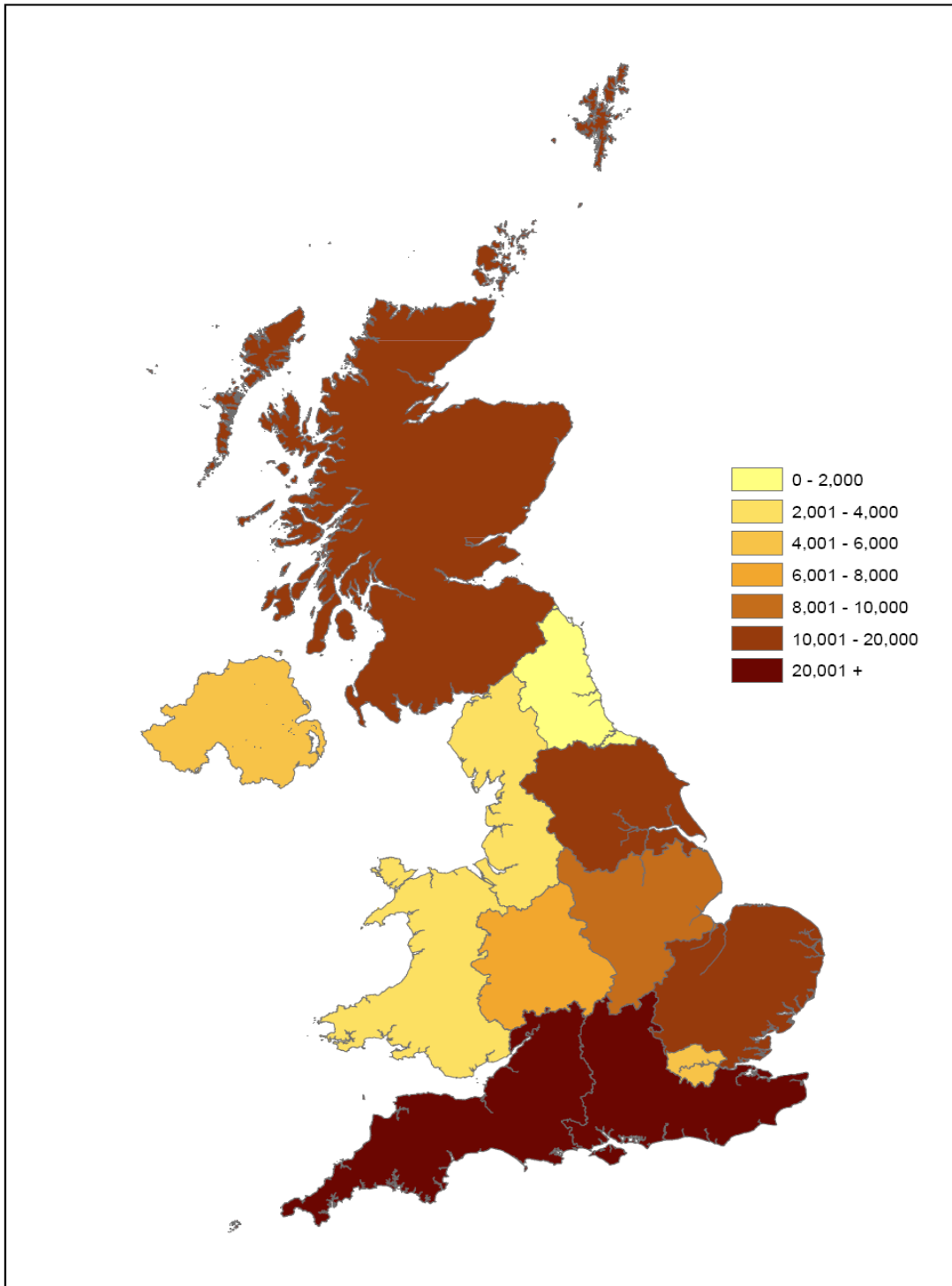

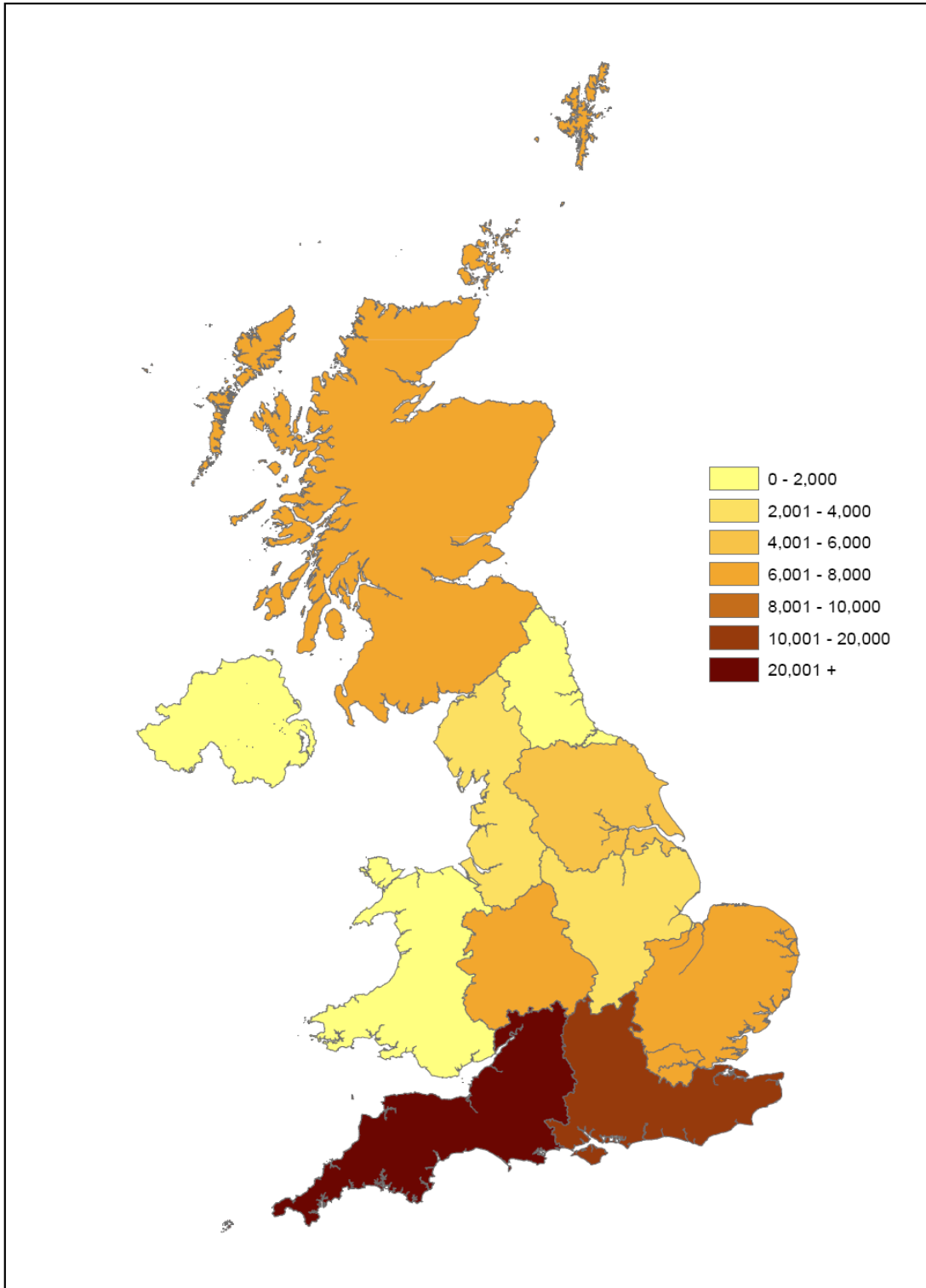
