I am aware of the large number of staff within DECC, so I would like to limit my enquiry only to Chris Nicholson, who I understand is a Special Adviser.

I would like each email, phone call or meeting logged with a time stamp and indicating, where possible, who were the parties involved. I would also like to see any notes that were attached to these exchanges, or, in the case of emails, the text of the messages where possible."

I have carried out a search of our electronic and paper records and I have established that the Department does not hold any information within scope of your request.

Appeals procedure

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to the Information Rights Unit (foi@decc.gsi.gov.uk).
