Forest View Primary School	4-11 Community School	315 Surplus of 17.8% in 2010/11.	82% - above national average.	Good	Moderate – the school has a high number of surplus places and is located only 0.41 miles away from St Anthony's. However, it is rapidly improving its results (increased from 63% in 2011 and 48% in 2010) and is not faith designated - parents wanting to send their children to a non-faith school may choose Forest View over St Anthony's. The school has recently converted to Academy status (Feb 2013). Free School unlikely to affect the long term viability of school.
St White's Primary School	4-11 Community School	315 Surplus of 13.3% in 2010/11	70% - below national average.	Satisfactory	Moderate – the school has a surplus of places, is performing below the national average and only achieved a satisfactory Ofsted rating. The school is further away from St Anthony's than the average distance travelled (1.3 miles away) to school and therefore is less likely to lose pupils – it is also not faith designated. Free School unlikely to affect the long term viability of school.
Littledean Church of England Primary School	4-11 Voluntary-Controlled School	105 Surplus of 5.7% in 2010/11	67% - below national average.	Good	Moderate – the school has a small number of surplus places and is performing under the national average. The Ofsted grade is good and the faith designation is different from St Anthony's and therefore is likely to still be a preference for CoE children. Free School unlikely to affect the long term viability of school.
Steam Mills Primary School	4-11 Community School	119 Surplus of 0.8%	94% - well above national average.	Good	Minimal – the Free School is unlikely to affect the long term viability of the school.
Soudley School	4-11 Community School	77 Surplus of 20.8%	88% - above national average.	Good	Moderate – high percentage of surplus places but good results and good Ofsted. No faith designation. The Free School is unlikely to affect the long term viability of the school.
Newnham St Peter's Church	4-11 Voluntary Aided School	140 Surplus of 27.9%	78% - just under national average.	Good	Moderate – whilst Newnham has a high number of surplus places, it is over 5 miles away from St

Drybrook Primary School	5-11 Community School	140 Surplus of 8.6%	83% - above national average	Good	Moderate – school has some surplus places but over 2.7 miles from proposed Free School site and not Catholic (or any faith) designated. Significant improvement in results since 2009. The Free School is unlikely to affect the long term viability of the school.
