

Annex B: Impact assessment for Trinity Academy

We have looked at 15 secondary schools within 2.0 mile radius of the proposed site of Trinity Academy. We have concluded that the free school will have a high impact on one, a moderate impact on two and unable to assess impact on one opened in 2013.
