EXTRACT FROM REPORT OF THE AUDITORS

We have audited the financial statements of the Sales Staff Association, set out on pages 2 to 5, which have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

The report is made solely to the association's members, as a body. Our audit work has been undertaken so that we might state to the association's members those matters we are required to state to them in an auditor's report and for no other purpose. Respective Responsibilities of the National Executive Committee and Auditors.
