The Environment Agency gives notice that the LTRAS was adopted on the 31st January 2014. It is available for inspection alongside its Environmental Report and a Statement of Environmental Particulars (in line with Regulation 16(4)) at the locations set out below.

The LTRAS sets out recommendations for managing flood risk from the River Arun from Pallingham Weir to the A259 at Littlehampton on the east bank, and to Ford railway line on the west bank. The recommendations also include the Black Ditch tributary.
