### Kingston Railway Bridge Between Teddington and Molesey Locks

**October 2013 to October 2014**

### **Maintenance Works to Kingston Railway Bridge**

Works (Grit blasting, painting, brick and steel work repairs) are required as part of a planned maintenance program to the existing bridge structure. This will incorporate the building of fully sealed purpose built access scaffolding in the respective arches.

Scaffolding will encapsulate the span/arch in which work is being undertaken leaving those remaining arches where work is not being undertaken free to navigation.

The works have been programmed to ensure that at least one of the three navigation spans/arches remains open to navigation throughout the program. **The Middle arch will remain open to navigation throughout the current works.** However, the headway will be restricted over the planned winter work period from October 2014.

Please follow directional signage, follow any directions given by the safety boat and/or officers of the Environment Agency and navigate slowly and with caution in the area of these works.

River Users are reminded that **boats going upstream must give way to boats coming downstream.**

NOTE: The visitor moorings on the upstream end of Kingston Wharf will be suspended for the duration of the works.
