Your request will be dealt with by the Bona Vacantia Division ("the Division") under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I have interpreted your request to mean that you require any information that we hold about the deceased's origins and/or extended family that will help you find entitled kin.

The information held by the Division in this regard in respect of each estate has been added to the unclaimed estates' list.

The information is reasonably accessible to you by other means and is therefore exempt from disclosure under section 21 of the Act.
