St Richard's RC School	3-11, co-ed, Roman Catholic, Voluntary aided Primary School	315 places and currently oversubscribed by 4.8% overall and no places available on entry	73% of pupils achieved the expected level at KS2 which was above the LA but slightly below the national average but fell significantly compared to the previous 2 years	Outstanding	<b>Minimal:</b> Currently oversubscribed, KS2 results are above the LA average and with an "outstanding" Ofsted rating. <b>The free school is very unlikely to affect the long term viability of this school</b>
St Joseph's RC School (Manchester)	3-11, co-ed, Roman Catholic, Voluntary aided Primary School	210 places with surplus of 2.4%, overall and no places available on entry	72% of pupils achieved the expected level at KS2 which was above the LA but slightly below the national average but fell slightly compared to the previous 2 years	Good	<b>Minimal:</b> Although showing a slight surplus overall there were no places available at entry level, KS2 results were above the LA average and Ofsted's rating was "good",. <b>The free school is unlikely to affect the long term viability of this school</b>
St James' CofE School, Birch-in-Rusholme	3-11, co-ed Church of Eng, Voluntary aided Primary School	210 places with surplus of 8.6%, overall and no places available on entry	77% of pupils achieved the expected level at KS2 which was above both the LA and national average but showed a falling trend when compared to the previous 2 years	Good	<b>Minimal:</b> Showing a surplus overall but there were no places available at entry level, KS2 results were above both the LA average and national average and Ofsted's rating was "good". <b>The free school is unlikely to affect the long term viability of this school</b>
Plymouth Grove School	3-11, co-ed, non-faith, Community Primary School	400 places with surplus of 14%, overall and 16 places available on entry	72% of pupils achieved the expected level at KS2 which was above the LA but slightly below the national average but this was a 21% increase compared to last year	Satisfactory	<b>Moderate:</b> Surplus places, both overall and at entry level and with an Ofsted rating as "satisfactory" compared to "good" ratings at other schools in the local area, so parents may look at other provision instead. However KS2 results are higher than the LA average and showed a significant increase on the previous year which is liable to be seen favourability by parents. <b>The free school is unlikely to affect the long term viability of this school</b>

Alma Park School	3-11, co-ed, non-faith, Community Primary School	420 places and currently oversubscribed by 0.7% overall and no places available on entry	74% of pupils achieved the expected level at KS2 which was above the LA and equal to the national average but slightly down on 2009 (no figures for 2010)	Outstanding	<b>Minimal:</b> Currently oversubscribed, KS2 results are above the LA and with an "outstanding" Ofsted rating. <b>The free school is very unlikely to affect the long term viability of this school</b>
Chapel Street School	3-11, co-ed, non-faith, Community Primary School	420 places and currently oversubscribed by 1.2% overall but with 14 places available on entry	73% of pupils achieved the expected level at KS2 which was above the LA but slightly below the national average but significantly up on 2009 (no figures for 2010)	Satisfactory	<b>Moderate:</b> due to surplus places at entry level and with Ofsted only rating the school as "satisfactory" compared to "good" ratings at other schools in the local area. However KS2 results are higher than the LA average and showed a significant increase on their previous 2009 results <b>The free school is unlikely to affect the long term viability of this school but may lose some places</b>
St Luke's CofE School	3-11, co-ed Church of Eng, Voluntary controlled Primary School	340 places with surplus of 14%, overall and no places available on entry	61% of pupils achieved the expected level at KS2, significantly below both the LA and with a slightly decreasing trend compared to the previous 2 years	Satisfactory	<b>Moderate:</b> KS2 results lower than both the LA and national average, an Ofsted rating of only satisfactory so parents may consider alternative provision. However, although the school has an overall surplus there are currently no surplus places indicated at entry level. Overall, therefore, <b>the free school is unlikely to affect the long term viability of this school, although it may attract some pupils from it.</b>
St Mary's RC School Manchester	3-11, co-ed Church of Eng, Voluntary aided Primary School	315 places with surplus of 4.1%, overall and with 6 places available on entry	85 of pupils achieved the expected level at KS2 which was above both the LA and national average and a significant increase on the previous 2 years	Good	<b>Minimal:</b> Although showing a slight surplus overall and some surplus places at entry level, KS2 results were the best of all schools in the local area and Ofsted's rating was "good". <b>The free school is unlikely to affect the long term viability of this school</b>
