

Chetwynde School, Barrow in Furness, Cumbria

Impact Assessment

We have looked at 10 schools within a 5.9 mile radius and 3 colleges within a 16.1 mile radius from the site from Chetwynde School. We have concluded that Chetwynde School's impact will vary between minimal and moderate, the details are set out below.
