Report on: Provider Appraisal Update

Introduction:

1. The Provider Appraisal directorate currently has six active assessments, of which one is due for decision this month and another two started this month. There are three ongoing transaction reviews and one ongoing quality governance review of a trust still in the NHS Trust Development Authority (NHS TDA) phase.

A. Developments

2. The Provider Appraisal Executive (PAE) agreed on 17 September 2014 that the Development team should start to scope a programme of work to develop a set of tools, processes and methodologies to support organisations develop and sustain effective cultures for high quality care. This guidance will be oriented around helping trusts develop and deliver on their leadership strategies that will underpin their overall organisational strategy. Work is ongoing in this area.

Continuous improvement

3. Further work is ongoing in small working groups of senior managers from the senior working group set up to discuss goals around running an efficient, effective Provider Appraisal directorate and to consider further Key Performance Indicators. The focus is on desired behaviours and measurable outcomes in four domains (Collective Leadership, Engaged and Motivated Team, Internal Efficiency and Minimising the Burden on Trusts).

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B. Update on assessments

- Royal United Hospital Bath NHS Trust, Bridgewater Community Healthcare NHS
 Trust and Derbyshire Community NHS Trust were all authorised last month
 effective 1 November 2014.
- 5. A list of the NHS trusts currently with Monitor for assessment and the reasons for any delay, deferral, postponement or withdrawal is provided in Annex 1 together with the anticipated timing of the relevant Care Quality Commission (CQC) inspection. Any changes from last month's report are highlighted in red.

Active assessments (exception reporting)

6. Bradford District Care NHS Trust has been referred to Monitor by the NHS TDA for assessment.

Assessment Pipeline

7. An overview of the assessment pipeline is provided in Annex 2. This reflects the NHS TDA's latest available published data (September 2014). The NHS TDA is currently undertaking sustainability reviews and is planning to update and publish its analysis of its pipeline, including which NHS trusts may be considered not sustainable in their current form, in November 2014.

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Making a difference for patients:

Monitor's mission is to make the health sector work better for patients. This report provides an update on the Provider Appraisal team. The key focus of this team is to assess if providers are well led and can therefore deliver sustainable high quality services to patients.

It is not considered that there are any decisions within this paper which would impact on protected groups Identified by the Act.

The information is exempt because disclosure of that information would, or would be likely to, inhibit the free and frank provision of advice, or exchange of views for the purposes of deliberation. In applying these exemptions, we have considered the public interest test; disclosure of this information will not enhance the accountability or transparency of Monitor as its disclosure would inhibit the free frank disclosure of information.
