This publication contains information on the numbers of Armed Forces personnel either applying or selected for redundancy in Tranche 4 of the UK Armed Forces Redundancy Programme (AFRP). Not all of those who applied were selected, and not all of those selected had applied for redundancy. The publication also details the maximum numbers that could have been selected for each rank and trade.

Key Points

- **At the end of 12th June 2014, 1,060 Armed Forces personnel were selected for redundancy, of whom 72% (760) were applicants.** Due to appeals, transfers and personnel leaving for other reasons, this may not reflect the number of personnel who will eventually leave in Tranche 4.
- **1,450 personnel applied for redundancy** in Tranche 4. Not all applicants were selected, where the number of applicants exceeded the maximum for selections in their field. Fields were based on rank, trade and length of service.
- This is the fourth and final tranche of the current Armed Forces Redundancy Programme. There is no further requirement for a redundancy programme to meet the personnel levels needed to satisfy the outcome of the Strategic Defence and Security Review published in 2010.

Release notes and definitions

The statistics in this report represent those who applied and those who were due to be notified of selection for redundancy at the close of business on June 12th 2014. They do not necessarily match the numbers of personnel eventually leaving the Services under the AFRP, due to appeals, movements of personnel into different roles not affected by AFRP and outflow for other reasons in the intervening time.

They will also not match numbers of selections compiled before or after 12th June for the same reasons – the lists held by the Services are live lists which could be updated daily.

Data Sources

Lists of applicants, selections and fields were obtained from the single Services. All data on personnel characteristics (age, sex, etc) were sourced from the Joint Personnel Administration system with a situation date of 1 June (the date closest to the selections.)

1. All tables presented in this publication meet the high standards of quality and integrity demanded by the Code of Practice for Official Statistics.
2. An updated Background Quality Report has been published in conjunction with this report. It provides detail on data quality.
