Could you possibly provide me with a breakdown by antibiotic class of the use of antibiotic growth promoters between 1998 and 2005?

As you will know, for the period 1998 to 2005, the VMD has published annual statistics on the use of antibiotic growth promoters (AGPs) in the Sales data reports, but did not provide any information on the use by antibiotic class for reasons of commercial confidentiality.

Since AGPs are no longer allowed in the UK or in the EU, my understanding is that there can no longer be any concerns about commercial confidentiality, so could you please provide me with a breakdown by antibiotic class of the AGPs between 1998 and 2005?
