

THE ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITTING (ENGLAND AND WALES)(F REDFERN AND SONS LTD) EXERCISE OF FUNCTIONS DIRECTION 2012

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the power conferred by regulation 33(1)(b) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010¹ ('the 2010 Regulations'), gives the following direction -


Citation and commencement

1. (1) This direction may be cited as the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales)(F Redfern and Sons Ltd) Exercise of Functions Direction 2012.
- (2) It comes into force on 19 July 2012.
- (3) The Environmental Permitting (England and Wales)(F Redfern and Sons Ltd) Exercise of Functions Direction 2008 which came into force on 28 July 2008 is hereby repealed.

Exercise of functions

2. (1) Functions under the 2010 Regulations in relation to the relevant operation are exercisable by Derbyshire Dales District Council for an indeterminate period unless a further direction is issued under regulation 33(1).
- (2) For the purpose of this direction "relevant operation" means the operation of a healthcare waste and veterinary clinical waste transfer station at the premises listed in the Schedule. Healthcare waste is limited to European Waste Catalogue² codes 18 01 03* and 20 01 99.
