- REVOCATION OF THE AUTHORISATION FOR A TYPE OF WORK OF A SCHEME OPERATOR AUTHORISED TO OPERATE A THIRD PARTY CERTIFICATION SCHEME

INTRODUCTION

- 1. I am directed by the Secretary of State to draw your attention to the Building Regulations &c. (Amendment) Regulations 2014 (S.I. 2014/2362) ("the Amendment Regulations"), which were made on 04 September 2014 and will come fully into force on 1 October 2014.
- 2. The purpose of this Circular is to:
 - draw attention to these amendments and explain the changes they make to the Building Regulations 2010 (S.I. 2010 No. 2214); and
 - announce the revocation of the authorisation a competent person selfcertification scheme for a type of work and the revocation of the authorisation of a third party certification scheme for a type of work.
- 3. The Annex to this Circular sets out in tabular form all the changes to the Building Regulations 2010 made by SI 2014/2362

APPLICATION OF THE REGULATIONS

4. The changes made by these Amendment Regulations apply in England and to excepted energy buildings in Wales.

REVOCATION OF AUTHORISATIONS

- 5. The Amendment Regulations revoke the authorisation of HETAS Limited to operate a competent person self-certification scheme in respect of the installation of oilfired combustion appliances or oil storage tanks and the pipes connecting them to combustion appliances.
- 6. The Amendment Regulations also revoke the authorisation of BSI Assurance UK Limited to operate a third party certification scheme in respect of electrical installations in dwellings.
