APPENDICES FOR ANIMAL WELFARE OF CALVES (SMR 16)

Size of individual stall or pen:

Width: must be at least equal to the height of the calf at the withers, when measured in the standing position

Length: at least equal to the body length of the calf (measured from the tip of

the nose to the rear of the pin bone (tuber ischii)) multiplied by 1.1

Amount of unobstructed floor space for each calf kept in a group:

Live weight of calf	Minimum amount of unobstructed floor space
Less that 150 kg	At least 1.5 square metres
Between 150 and 200 kg	At least 2 square metres
200 kg or more	At least 3 square metres

Fibrous food ration:

The daily fibrous food ration rises in line with the growth of the calf; starting at 100g at two weeks old and rising to 250g at 20 weeks.
