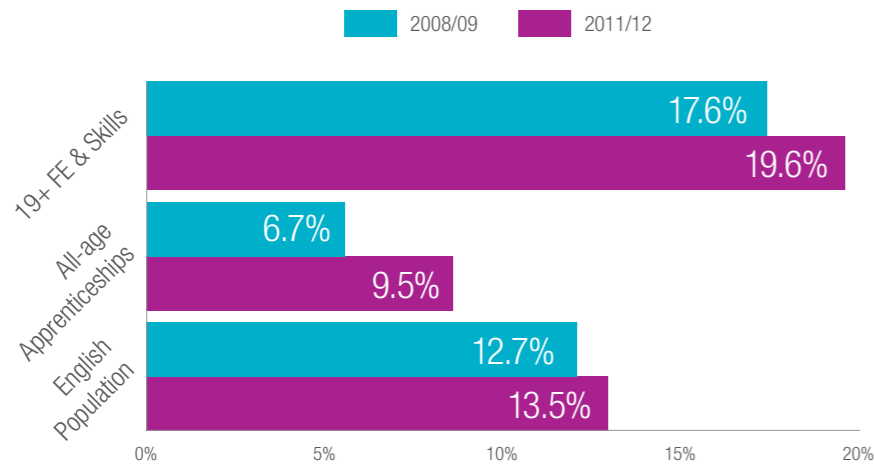
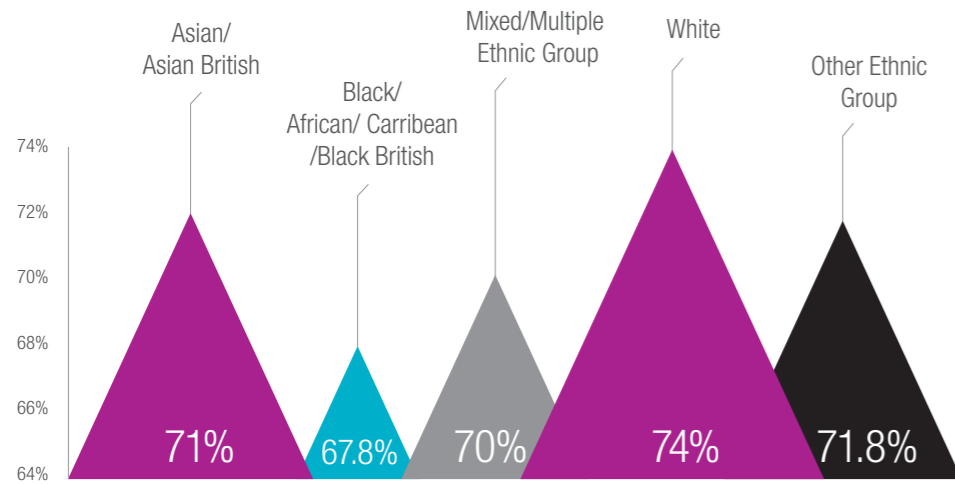


How well does FE and Skills provision meet the needs of different groups of learners?

Good representation of learners from black, asian and minority ethnic backgrounds. Low in Apprenticeships but increasing.



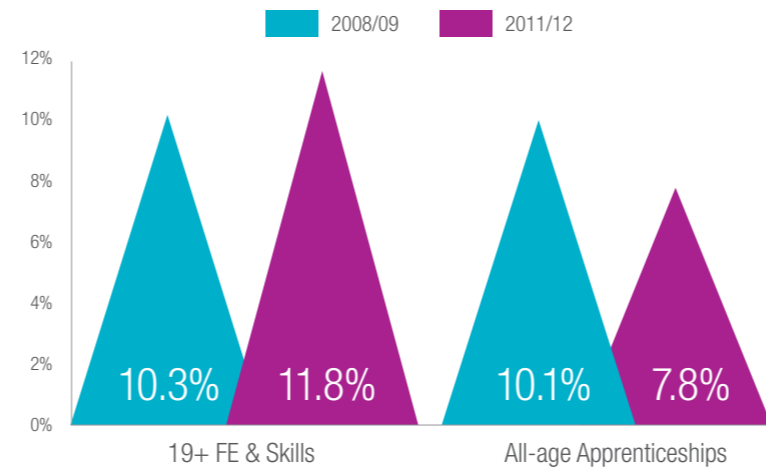
White apprentices have a success rate 6 percentage points higher than black learners.



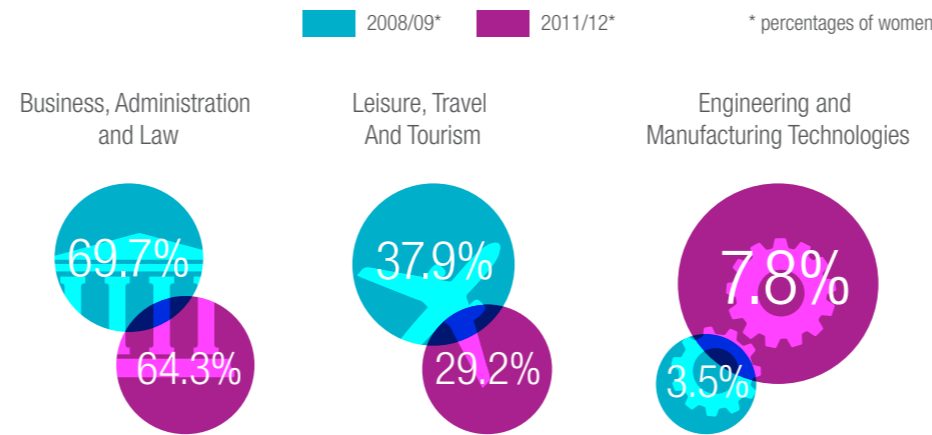
Learners that experience harassment or bullying.



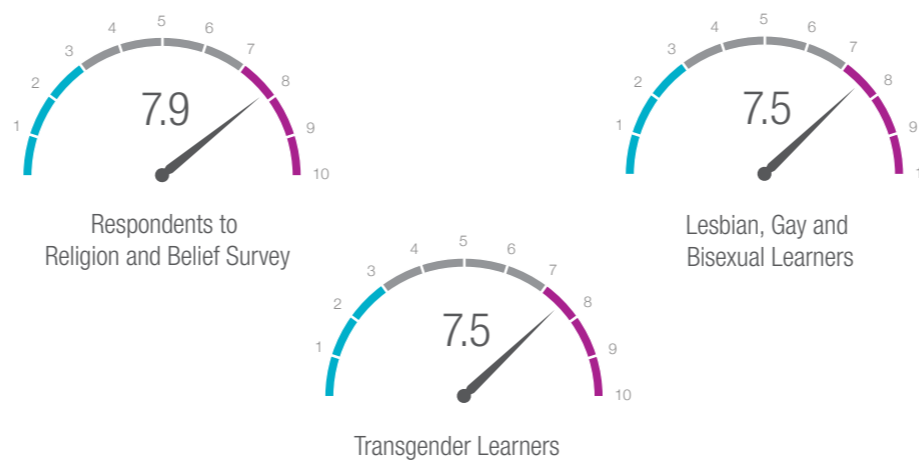
Overall proportion with learning difficulties and/or disabilities is increasing but falling in Apprenticeships.



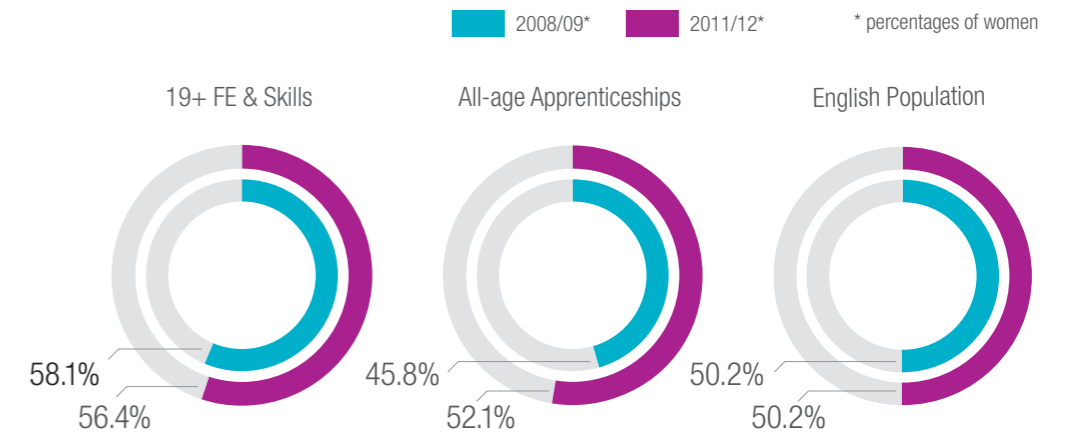
Apprenticeships remain gender stereotypical by sector, but some gaps are closing.



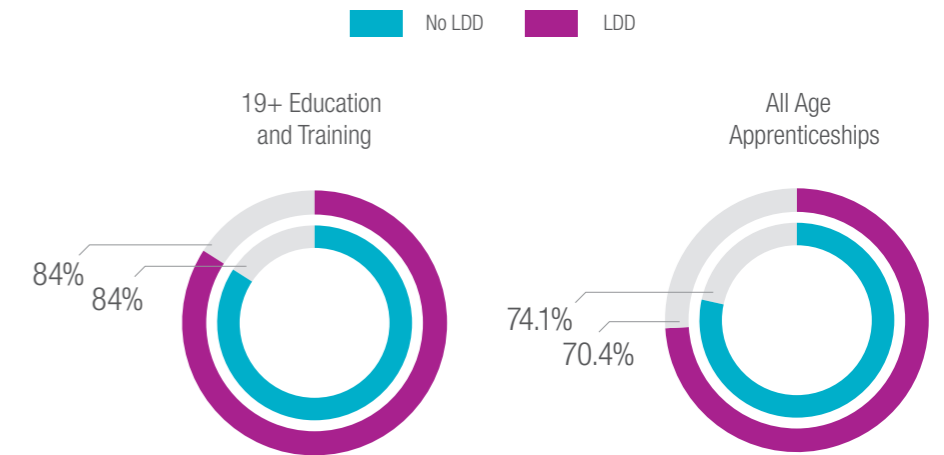
How welcoming is FE on a scale of 1 to 10?
