Surrender

We have decided to accept the surrender of the permit for **Heath Farm** operated by Banham Group Limited.

The permit number is EPR/FP3630UY

We are satisfied that the necessary measures have been taken to avoid any pollution risk and to return the site to a satisfactory state.

We consider in reaching that decision we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements.

Key issues of the decision

The facility has a permitted capacity of 160,000 spaces for rearing of broilers. However the site has fallen out of our regulation as it is now operating below the threshold of 40,000 places for poultry. As a result the listed activity, S6.9 A(1)(a)(i) - Rearing poultry intensively in an installation with more than 40,000 places for poultry, is no longer relevant to the site thereby necessitating the need to surrender the permit.
