- does the MDP follow the ACPO vetting process for new police officers or rather so they
have their own bespoke process due to the nature of their job"?

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held

Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate the case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
