## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

Thank you for your e-mail Freedom of Information request. On the 14<sup>th</sup> of April you asked the Highways Agency for the following information:

- The numbers of staff employed by TMD on a year by year basis on April 1<sup>st</sup> from 2010 to 2014.
- The numbers employed (in post) in a front line role. i.e. Traffic Officers on road and off including ROMs Oms and TMs
- The numbers employed (in post) in support roles.

The Highways Agency do not classify specific staff into 'On Road' and 'Support staff' in their HR system which is the Agency's most accurate system to answer your question. In the attached document we have provided the total number of Traffic Officers in the Traffic Management Directors (TMD) and broken them down into their pay grades and directorates which is the most accurate way we can answer your request without exceeding the Freedom of Information cost limit.

In keeping with the spirit and effect of the legislation, all information is assumed to be releasable to the public unless exempt.
