## Secondary schools with a high impact rating

There is only one local secondary school, Hurlingham and Chelsea ('Inadequate', 2013), where the impact is considered to be high. This is mainly because of its proximity to FBS, along with the fact that it has spare places. However, the impact is mitigated by the school being mixed and non-faith. This school would therefore not generally be considered by parents who would send their children to FBS, as the single-sex, Church of England aspect that FBS offers is a major factor in their choice.
