## **Notes**

- 1. This form (C 944) MUST NOT be used for report if the vessel has called at a foreign port, or at a work point. (A work point includes all drilling and production platforms, pipelaying barges, fire fighting ships, rig safety and diving support vessels). If it has, a full report is to be made in accordance with Notice 69.
- 2. The report must be handed to the Customs officer who boards the vessel on arrival, or if not boarded on arrival, delivered to the designated place in the port within THREE hours.
- 3. Two copies of this form are normally to be completed, one copy as the Customs' record and a second to be retained on board the vessel. If however the port of arrival is different from the port of previous departure a third copy must be completed for Customs & Excise.
