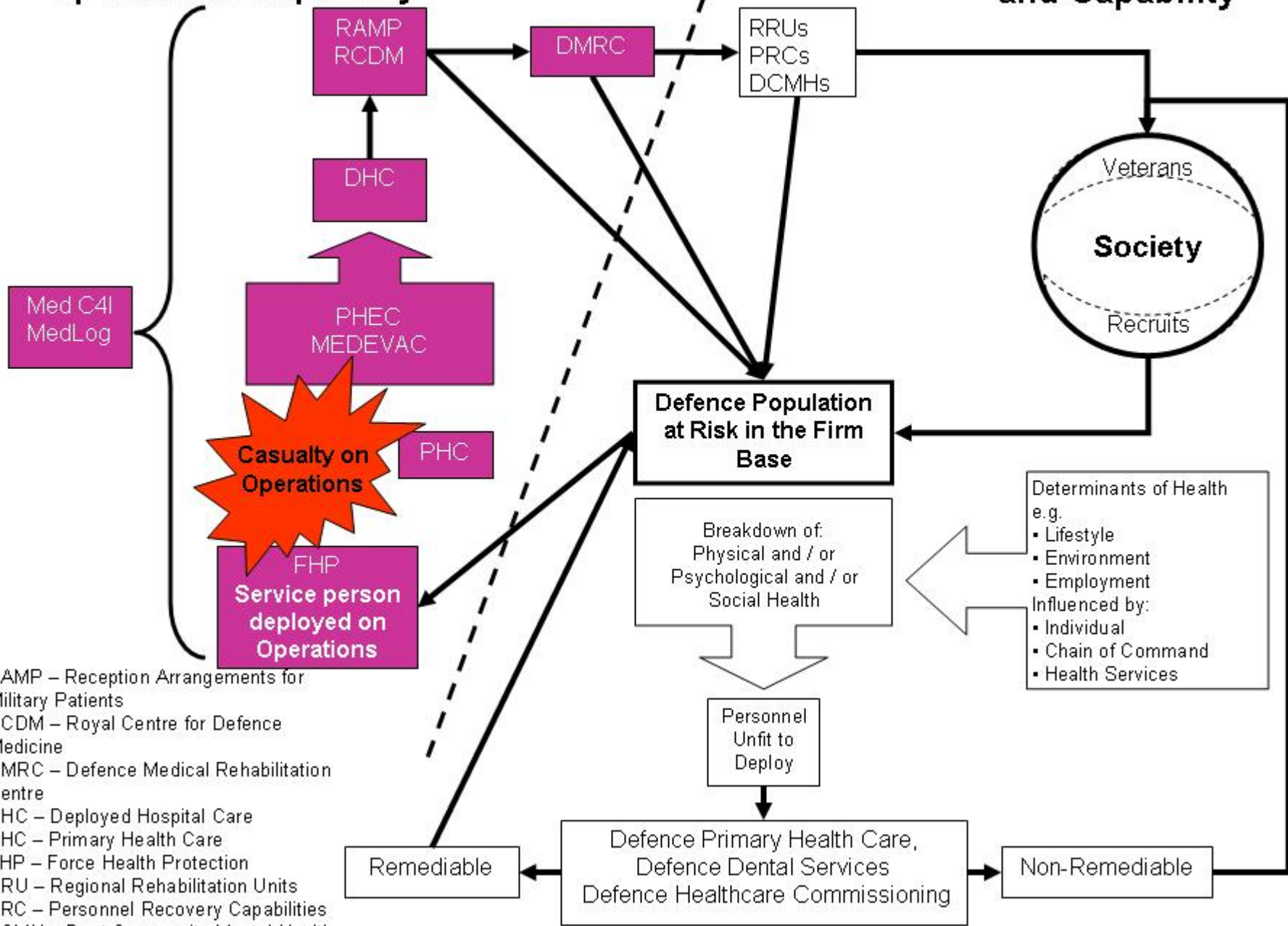

Medical Operations and Operational Capability

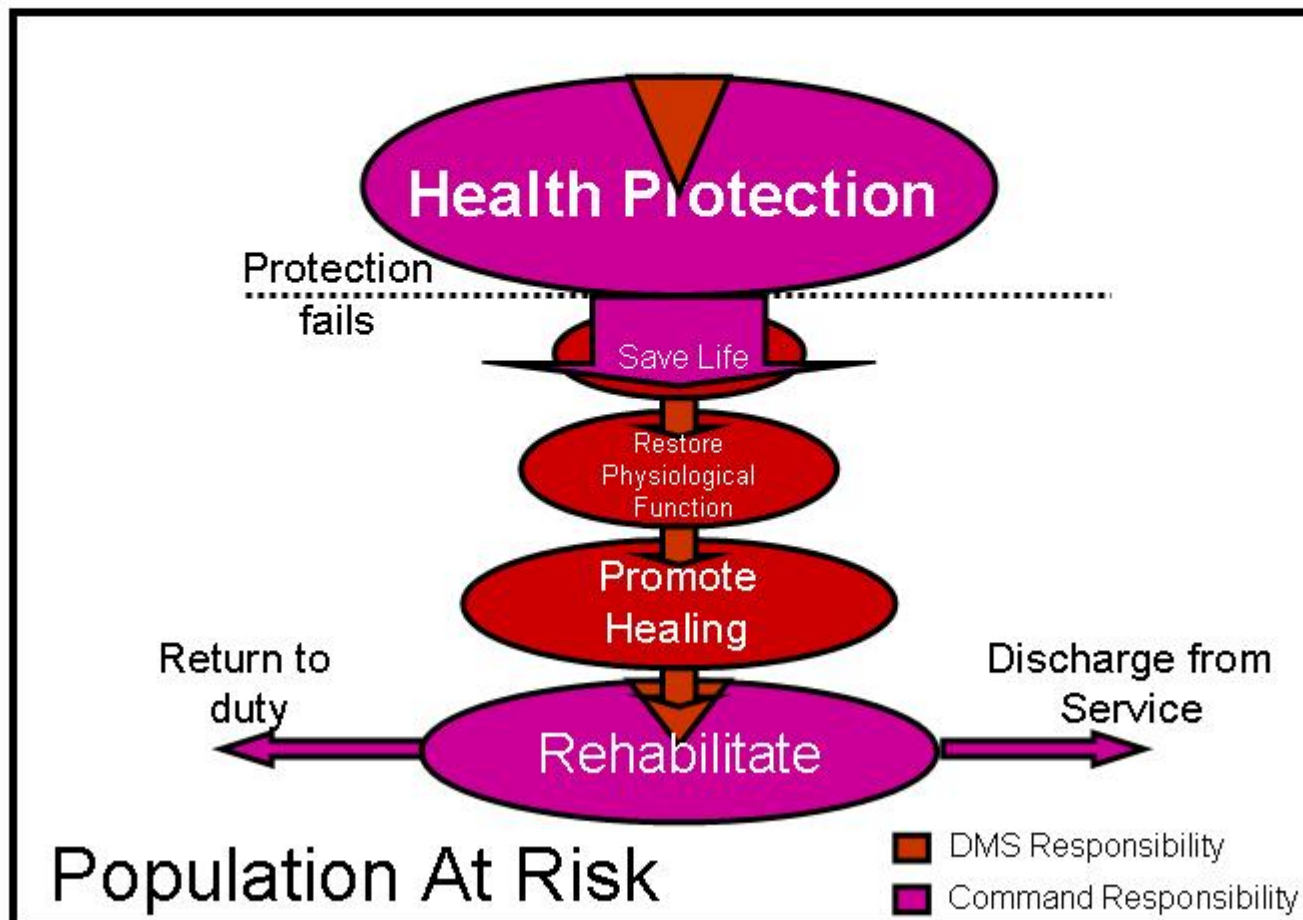
Firm Base Medical Activity and Capability



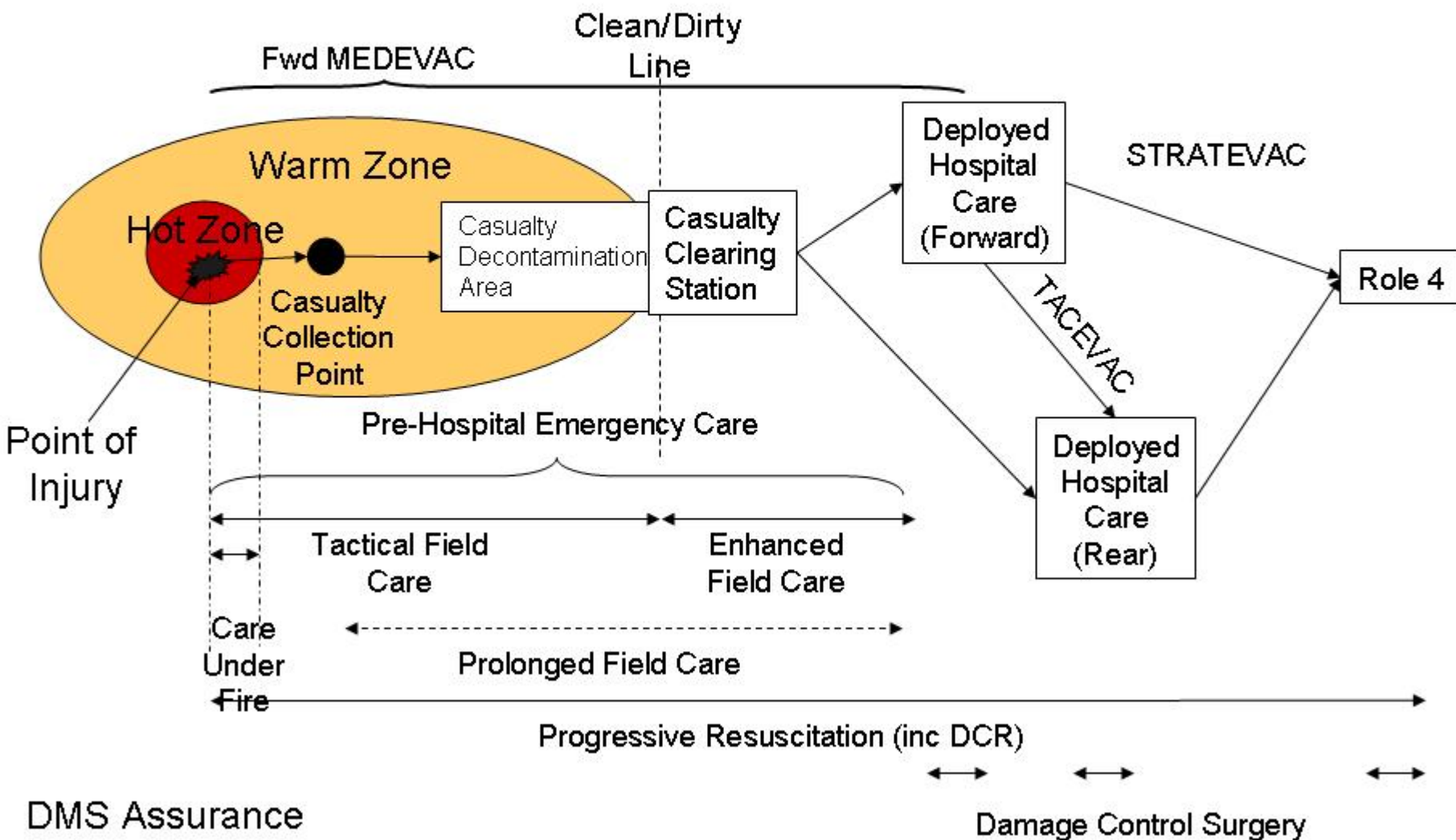

Triage Categories

Category and colour	Meaning	Implications	Notes
T1 – Red	Immediate	Requires life-saving interventions. Should be evacuated as fast as possible.	Evacuation times are specified in the '9 liner' MEDEVAC request
T2 – Yellow	Urgent	Requires interventions. Should be evacuated within 2 hours.	
T3 – Green	Delayed	Requires evacuation (clinical or operational reasons). Should be evacuated when possible/safe.	
DEAD – White on Black	Dead	No further medical intervention Requires movement.	
T4 - Blue	Expectant	Requirement for clinical intervention exceeds local capacity. Supportive care only.	Only used when authorised declaration of a Mass Casualty Incident.
