I regret that we do not hold lists of top filers from specified countries and the cost of producing such a list would exceed the appropriate limit for FOI requests.

I should explain that section 12 of the FOI Act makes provision for public authorities to refuse requests for information where the cost of dealing with them would exceed the appropriate limit, which for central government is set at £600. This represents the estimated cost of one person spending 3.5 working days in determining whether the department holds the information, locating, retrieving and extracting the information.

We estimate that it would take us in excess of 3.5 working days to determine appropriate material and locate, retrieve and extract the information in reference to your request.
