




Rail passenger numbers and crowding on weekdays in major cities in England and Wales: 2013



Key

AM peak arrivals is the number of passengers arriving into the city centre by national rail on a typical autumn weekday during the three hour morning peak (7-10am).

Peak PiXC is the percentage of passengers in excess of capacity (PiXC) across the morning and evening peaks on a typical autumn weekday. It is the main measure of crowding in these statistics. A higher PiXC percentage represents a worse crowding level.
