Your email dated 11th July 2014 is considered to be a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000. You requested the following information:

Can you please provide me under the FOI act a list of all successful and non successful tenders and information contained within these tenders for contracts awarded relating to Fire suppression used within the MOD or used on MOD vehicles for the past 10 years.

CPV35111500: Fire suppression system.

I can confirm that the Ministry of Defence (MOD) holds some information relevant to your request. The MOD primarily procures its fire suppression systems and requirements as an integral part of the equipment platform or building, or against a wider maintenance contract, rather than by means of separate tender action. However, we have identified a total of nine contracts for fire suppression against CPV 35111500, the details for which are shown in the Annex to this letter. There are two contracts for which we have, as yet, been unable to identify the other tenders (if any). Both contracts are closed and the details are to be retrieved from archive.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, 1st Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
