Homeland Security Project Portfolio

This project portfolio provides Science and Technology (S&T) support to a number of Government departments – through their individual and jointly funded projects – and focuses on many aspects of homeland security, from policy advice to S&T delivery.

Areas of interest include:

- analysis to inform security policy
- threat detection and mitigation, including for explosives
- S&T support to transport and border security
- data analytics for security applications
- S&T support to counter-terrorism.



The project portfolio works to link the Ministry of Defence's (MOD's) S&T Programme and other Government departments to ensure that defence and security S&T is shared to realise best value for homeland security. The project portfolio's key stakeholders include MOD, the Home Office, Department for Transport, the Cabinet Office and Government Office for Science.
