1. The figures for the amount of CBT certificates sold to ATBs since 2004?

As advised in my email of 9 May 2013, the number of CBT certificates sold to ATBs since the 2004/05 financial year and up to the 2010/11 financial year can be found on our website at: <http://www.dft.gov.uk/foi/dsa-ia0088711>. This information is exempt from release under section 21 (information accessible by other means) of FoIA. A copy of this exemption is attached at Annex A.

Details of certificates sold since the 2011/12 financial year are published in table INS0503 as an official statistic and can be found at: <https://www.gov.uk/government/statistical-data-sets/ins05-compulsory-training-and-incident-statistics>. Data for the period 1 January to 31 March 2013 is due to be published on 27 June and will be available using the above link. This information is exempt from release under section 44 (1)(a) (prohibitions on disclosure) by virtue of the Pre-release Access to Official Statistics Order 2008 which limits access to official statistics until their date of publication. As this exemption is an absolute exemption we are not required to conduct a public interest test. A copy of this exemption in full can be found at Annex B.

2. Mod 2 A1 tests broken down by gender and age since 1997?

Module 2 tests were introduced on 27 April 2009 and prior to this date, there was a single motorcycle test. The table below shows the number of tests by gender and age for the single test and the module 2 test. Please note that we do not hold any data prior to the 2004/05 financial year.

Whilst you requested this information broken into the age and gender of the candidate, due to the small numbers, it could be linked to individuals and this information would be classed as personal data. Personal data is exempt from release under section 40 (2) of the Freedom of Information Act, a copy of which is attached at Annex C. We have, however, provided this information broken down by age bandings except for the period covering the 1 April to 26 April 2009 where a total for all tests has been provided.
