

“Information on two projects, ‘Act Global’, and its linked social network, ‘Act Global: Red’.”

DFID holds some information relevant to your request. This relates to the ‘Act Global’ project which was funded by DFID through the Development Awareness Fund (DAF), and is now closed.

I have set out our response to each of your questions below.

How much was spent on each project over their lifespans?

A total of £202,657.74 was paid to Relief International UK, the grant-holder, during the lifespan of the ‘Act Global’ project.

Whether either project survives in any form?

DFID does not hold information relevant to this part of your request. You may, however, wish to know that information about Act Global, including the project teaching resources, remains freely and easily available on the internet.

Whether any full time staff worked on either project.

The Act Global project funded two full time project staff.

I would also be interested in seeing any correspondence between DFID (who funded both projects) and Relief International UK and the Citizenship Foundation, who delivered it, especially related to targets set by DFID for effectiveness, and how the projects fulfilled them.
