2014-2020 programme allocations

The Government has confirmed how the €6.2 billion England allocation of the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) and the European Social Fund (ESF) will be allocated. ERDF, ESF and part of the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD) will be allocated to Local Enterprise Partnerships (LEP) areas for a seven year period through an EU Growth Programme. Further guidance will be published in July.
