A332 Windsor/Eton relief road bridge to Firework Ait near Windsor and Eton footbridge, Windsor

Sunday 15 June 2014 – 06.00am to 09.30am

Humanrace – The Royal Windsor Triathlon

Directions for navigation and mooring during this closure:

- The river between A332 Windsor/Eton Relief Road Bridge and Firework Ait near Windsor and Eton footbridge, Windsor will be **closed to all traffic** other than authorised vessels between 06.00am and 09.30am. Please note that to facilitate this Boveney and Romney locks will be closed during this event.
- We ask river users to note the details of this **temporary** river closure which is in place for the safety of both swimmers and other river users due to the works on Windsor Viaduct (Rail Bridge) overrunning as a consequence of the January / February 2014 Floods.
- Masters of vessels in the area are to **remain moored** during the closure.

Nothing contained in these directions shall supersede those parts of the Thames Navigation Licensing and General Byelaws 1993 as may be relevant.

And Notice is hereby given, that it is provided by Byelaw 52 of the Thames Navigation Licensing and General Byelaws, 1993 that:

The master of any vessel shall except in an emergency not pass any boat-race regatta public procession or gathering for the launch of a vessel or any other event or function which may cause a crowd to assemble on or by the river nor station his vessel thereon in such a manner as would risk obstructing impeding or interfering with such boat-race regatta procession launching event or function or endangering the safety of persons assembling on the river or preventing or interfering with the maintenance of order thereon.

The maximum penalty for breach of this Byelaws is £1000
