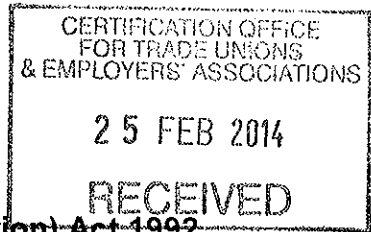

## Expenditure


Expenditure is accounting for on an accruals basis. All amounts of irrecoverable VAT are added to expenditure incurred.

## Independent Auditor's Report to the Members of The Social Workers Union

We have audited the financial statements of The Social Workers Union for the year ended 30 September 2013 on pages 3 to 19 which have been prepared under the accounting policies set out on page 19.

This report is made solely to The Social Workers Union's members, as a body. Our audit work has been undertaken so that we might state to The Social Workers Union's members those matters we are required to state to them in an auditor's report and for no other purpose. To the fullest extent permitted by law, we do not accept or assume responsibility to anyone other than The Social Work Union and The Social Workers Union' members as a body, for our audit work, for this report, or for the opinions we have formed.

## Respective responsibilities of the Executive Committee and auditor

The Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 and the Trade Union Reform and Employment Rights Act 1993 require the officers of The Social Workers Union to: keep proper accounting records which give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of The Social Workers Union and explain its transactions; establish and maintain a satisfactory system of control of the accounting records, cash holding and all the receipts and remittances; prepare an annual return for the Certification Officer giving a true and fair view of the revenue account and balance sheet and provide members of The Social Workers Union with a statement of income and expenditure for the year. Our responsibility is to audit and express an opinion on the financial statements in accordance with applicable law and International Standards on Auditing (UK and Ireland). In addition, we read all the financial and non-financial information in the Annual Return to identify material inconsistencies with the audited financial statements. If we become aware of any apparent material misstatements or inconsistencies we consider the implications for our report.

## Opinion on financial statements


In our opinion the financial statements:
