I acknowledge receipt of your e-mail message of 25 June 2014, which we dealing with as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

In your e-mail of 25 June 2014, you requested the following information:

"Please could you tell me the average cost of overtime incurred for each officer (or as a total for the station) at RAF Mildenhall / Lakenheath for the period 01/09/2011 to the present day. This would include all public holidays worked including scheduled and unscheduled overtime".

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

Please note that these figures represent the total amount of overtime paid during the periods identified.

Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
