Thank you for your email of 12 September 2014 requesting the following information:

I am looking for information regarding the following:

KNIFE, KIT SURVIVAL, 8465-99-125-3686 (RAF Stores Code 22P/11) KNIFE, CLASP 7340-99-125-3697 (RAF Stores code 22P/32)

In relation to both items above I am looking for in and out of service dates, manufacturers of the items and if possible numbers manufactured.

Also in relation to KNIFE, CLASP 7340-99-125-3697 an image or drawing of the item is also requested.

Details are also required for 5110-99-794-0491, including official description, in and out of service dates, manufacturers of the items and if possible numbers manufactured.

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that some information in scope of your request is held.

Official Description: "Knife Pocket".

Manufacturer: Joseph Rogers Ltd

No details are available of the numbers manufactured. You may wish to note that for consumable items there are no in and out of service dates.

A search of our records has not found any information relating to the other knives in which you are interested. We have also asked our industry partners whether they hold any relevant information, and they do not.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance.
