Freedom of information request: Weather modification In UK

Thank you for your email, dated 2nd June 2014, where you requested the following information:

Further to your response dated 23 July 2013, I would be most grateful if you would elaborate further on the types of weather modifications referred to in the Royal Society report you reference as I was unable to locate these.

Also, are any of these weather modification techniques being deployed in or above the UK, or have they been in the last 10 years?

Your request has been considered under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIRs) as the information you have sought disclosure of does, in our view, fall within the definition of 'environmental information' as stated in the EIRs.

Under the EIRs you have the right to:

- know whether we hold the information you require
- be provided with that information (subject to any exceptions under the Regulations which may apply).

In response to your first question, section 1.4 on page 4 of the Royal Society report highlights historical attempts to stimulate rain and to divert hurricanes.

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that this Department does not hold any record of any weather modification techniques being deployed in or above the UK currently or over the last 10 years.



Appeals Procedure
