## Geographical distribution of users

We have used information from the 2011 Census in order to provide proportional figures (total number of ILF Users per 10,000 of population). We have also provided a comparison with DWP statistics from February 2014 and Department for Social Development (NI) statistics from November 2013 on (working age) recipients of highest care component of DLA (currently in payment),
