NOTICE.

In this list each series of charts is arranged consecutively with the information concerning them tabulated. In the first column the number of the chart, plan, or diagram is given; followed in the second column by the title. In the succeeding columns is given, when possible, the approximate scale of the chart or plan; the size of the work; the date of production; and the date of the last new edition.

THE NUMBER OF THE CHART will be found in the bottom right-hand corner of the sheet.

THE TITLES are those given on the chart, plan, or diagram; that of the coast sheet or general title comes first, and the titles of the plans, which are usually of places within the area covered by the coast sheet, follow underneath. If the chart or diagram does not bear a title, one descriptive of the geographical area embraced by the chart or of the nature of the diagram, will be given. Alternative or secondary names are shown in brackets.

THE SCALE is given to the nearest tenth of an inch. A Geographical or Nautical mile, *i.e.*, a Minute of Mid-latitude is the unit of measurement referred to when the figures are preceded by "m ="; and a Degree at Mid-latitude when by "d =."

THE SIZE is that of the limits of the actual work given to the nearest inch, and when the work is surrounded with a border or graduation the dimensions are taken within the inner lines of the border or graduation. In some cases part of the work is on a slip which is joined to the main portion of the sheet, and this is indicated by an "s" placed against the figures.

THE DATES on the charts or diagrams will be found under the bottom margin; the "Date of Production" being in the middle; and on the right of this the date, if any, of the last "New Edition," or "Large Correction" as it is styled on the older charts.
