AGREEMENT REACHED IN THE CHIEF OFFICERS' COMMITTEE

- 1. The Chief Officers' Committee of the Police Negotiating Board has previously reached agreement on the introduction of a revised pay scale for Assistant Chief Constables and Commanders. It was agreed that changes to the pay scale would take place in three stages over two years from the 1 June 2014. Pay points 1, 3 and 5 will be removed in June 2014, 2015 and 2016 respectively. The purpose of this circular is to set out the changes which will come into effect from the 1 June 2014. The new pay scales, alongside existing scales, are detailed in the attached memorandum.
- 2. This PNB agreement has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Home Department. Local policing bodies now have the authority to implement this agreement*. In due course, the relevant Minister will make formal determinations.
